**ORDINANCE No 212 -2016**

**AN ORDINANCE OF BRECKNOCK TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, REVISING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF THE  
BRECKNOCK TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES, KNOWN AS THE  
BRECKNOCK TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1993**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Brecknock Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, finds that it is desirable to amend the Zoning Ordinance of Brecknock Township to revise regulations regarding the sale of plant, nursery and garden materials.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of Brecknock Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts the following amendment to the Brecknock Township Zoning Ordinance:

**Section 1**

Amend Article VII, Performance Regulations, by revising the following:

- Amend §110-68.A, to read as follows: “The sale of non-plant items, excluding peat moss and mulch, shall be incidental to the business. The display area for such items shall not exceed 15% of the total gross display and sales area on the subject property or 1,500 square feet, whichever is greater.”

**Section 2**


All other sections, parts and provisions of the Zoning Ordinance for Brecknock Township as heretofore enacted and amended shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 3**

These amendments shall take effect as provided for by law, and all ordinance provisions inconsistent with these amendments are hereby repealed and deleted.


