

# NOTICE

The Brecknock Township, Lancaster County, Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP) for Little Muddy Creek, UNT to Muddy Creek, Muddy Creek, Conestoga River and the Chesapeake Bay Watershed is available for public review and comment by request at the Township Building at 1026 Dry Tavern Road, Denver, PA 17517. It will also be made available on the Township website at <http://brecknocktownship.us/>. Written comments from the public will be accepted from August 1, 2017 to August 31, 2017. Verbal and written comments will also be accepted during the Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors Meeting scheduled for August 8, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the Township Building. The PRP describes the existing loading of pollutants discharged from the Brecknock Township MS4 to Little Muddy Creek, UNT to Muddy Creek and Muddy Creek which subsequently drain to the Conestoga River and Chesapeake Bay and presents a plan to reduce these pollutants. The PRP is a requirement of the Township's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to conduct such other business as may come before it.
