

Brecknock Township  
Board of Supervisors Meeting  
September 10, 2019

The regular meeting of the Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors, Lancaster County that was scheduled for September 10, 2019 was held at the Brecknock Township Building, 1026 Dry Tavern Road, Fivepointville. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jerry Long at 7:00 p.m.

At this time the Pledge of Allegiance took place followed by Roll Call of Officials.

Present were David Leinbach, Arthur Zerbe & Jerry Long.

Elizabeth Magovern was present as Township Solicitor, Mike Reinert was present as Township Engineer and Carol Martin also noting herself as being present.

Community Open Session

Gene Martini noted that the Road crew did a nice job at Oberholtzer Rd. Said the township has a good crew.

Arthur Zerbe mentioned the road crew did a good job on Gehman School Road.

GUEST – Ron Hershey of Hershey Surveying was present representing the lot add on plan for 128 W. Maple Grove Rd. The lot owner Luke Ulrich also owns a lot that connects to this lot so they are taking a small piece and adding it to 128 W. Maple Grove Rd. Motion was made by Long and seconded by Zerbe to grant waivers of 95-18-D(2), 98-28.B(3)(i) & 47 as presenting. All in favor, motion was approved.

Motion was made by Long and seconded by Leinbach to grant conditional final plan approval. All in favor, motion was approved.

Motion was made by Leinbach and seconded by Zerbe to accept the August 13, 2019 Board of Supervisors meeting minutes as submitted. All in favor, motion was approved.

A motion was made by Zerbe and seconded by Leinbach to approve the bills as presented. All in favor, motion was approved.

The following items within the engineering report require Board action/approval this month:

5. **Frank Pudlo SWM** – Issued financial security release recommendation dated August 21, 2019 in the amount of \$250.00.
6. **Jay Paul Martin SWM** – Issued financial security release recommendation dated August 15, 2019 in the amount of \$2,500.00.

7. **Samuel Brubaker SWM** – Issued financial security release recommendation dated September 5, 2019 in the amount of \$3,000.00.
8. **Daryl Nolt SWM** – Issued financial security release recommendation dated September 4, 2019 in the amount of \$13,025.00.

A motion was made by Zerbe and seconded by Leinbach to accept and approve all of the recommendations noted in the Township Engineers report. All in favor, motion approved.

A motion was made by Zerbe and seconded by Leinbach to accept the Roadmaster, Engineer, SEO & Zoning reports as presented. All in favor, motion approved.

**PARK & RECREATION** The Park Board would like permission to hold a Trunk or Treat event in the Brubaker Park on Oct. 26<sup>th</sup>. Families would walk through the park and go from parked car to parked car and receive candy or non-food items from each car. The families would also vote on the best three decorated vehicles which would get a prize not yet determined. They are looking for an approval to spend no more than \$600 on the event. The board asked that for safety reasons each vehicle must register so that we can keep records of who was there. Motion was made by Zerbe and seconded by Leinbach to authorize the event as requested. All in favor, motion was approved.

Park Board presented a park survey to the board for approval to seek opinions of residents regarding activities, facilities, etc. They would like to place a link on the township website that would take everyone to an online survey. This comes with a minimal fee of \$25.00 per month while active. They are also planning to place an Ad in local papers to get the word out about the survey as well. After some discussion a motion was made by Long and seconded by Leinbach to proceed with the survey. All in favor, motion was approved.

**OLD BUSINESS** – Act 537 Plan/Special Study – no new update at this time.

Motion was made by Zerbe and seconded by Leinbach to approve the draft Pathways lease agreement for 1 year with the option of extended to an additional year for the Farm house in Brubaker Park. All in favor, motion was approved.

A motion was made by Leinbach to adjourn at 7:54pm Zerbe seconded. All in favor, motion approved.
